 Ecuador

- Supporting **local actors** – devolving decision making.
- **Agile and flexible funding system** – simplifying reporting and monitoring.
- **Connector role** – bringing together multidisciplinary professionals.
- Supporting **bottom-up and grassroots** initiatives.
- Prioritising **vulnerable regions and community heritage**.
- Embedding culture in **humanitarian action** while understanding that human lives come first.


CULTURAL EMERGENCY RESPONSE

- PROFESSIONALS READY TO COORDINATE ACTIONS ON THE GROUND.



Emergency Response Projects– Action Plan Development




CER – Ukraine Action Plan

- **Culture targeted in the war.**
- **Workers, museums, collections, sites, monuments and historic buildings in need of protection.**
- **Pooled funds from grant-makers.**

Phase 1

- 1** Support **damage and forensic data collection missions.**
- 2** Support for **rapid cultural emergency response grants** for smaller and/or independent heritage and cultural institutions affected by the conflict- any first- aid action to wide range of cultural heritage.
- 3** **CER as a knowledge hub** – coordinating, connecting and sharing resources, knowledge and expertise with local partners and through its network of international heritage experts.



CER – Ukraine Action Plan

- **Mid-term.**
- After immediate emergency response phase.

Phase 2

- 1 Follow-up funding for further first aid actions to continue activities and/or operational support.
- 2 Go-to centre or hub to allow coordination of materials, expertise, training, and other support needed on the ground, in close collaboration with local and international partners.
- 3 Emergency conservation projects for damaged cultural heritage. Evacuations and adaptation of spaces for secure storage.



 Ukraine

CER – Mali Action Plan

- Situation analysis
- Mapping stakeholders
- Preparation for risk and damage assessment missions

Phase 1

- 1 Coordinating with previous project partners with active projects in Sudan and mapping available professionals inside and outside Sudan
- 2 Coordinating a conference to gather all stakeholders- ICCROM leading the preparations for damage and risk assessment missions.
- 3 Emergency conservation projects for damaged cultural heritage. Evacuations and adaptation of spaces for secure storage.
